Conclusions (I)

- RIS3 are Romania's key supporting strategies for SDGs strongly involved in the process offers a strong asset towards the "localized SDGs".
- RIS3 are also supportive for other seven SDGs and complementary to the sectoral strategies (i.e. agriculture, energy, environment etc.). RIS3 comes in with the technological innovative solutions.
- RIS3 offers strong support for the digital transformation almost exclusively the private sector!
- RIS3 gives prominent attention to sustainable production which are critical to the green transition – i.e. energy, economy, construction, environment – are not in focus in all regions.
- Inclusive growth is not an explicit goal for RIS3.
