- National RDI strategy 2014-2020 - includes national RIS3 priorities:
- Bio-economy** (Food, Agriculture, Pharma, Biomass, Biofuel)
  - ICT, space & security (Soft & hardware, spatial infrastructure, information security etc.)
- Energy, environment & climate change** (new sources of energy, smart grids, environmental protection, smart cities)
  - Eco-nano-technologies & advanced materials** (KETs, vehicles, advanced materials)
    - Health
- 8 regional RIS3;
- About 80 bil. Euro for 2021-2027 (MFF & RRF); about 15 bil. Euro for R&D & innovation & digitalisation + about 25 bil. Euro for green transition

### 3. METHODOLOGY

**INDICATORS OF THE ANALYSIS**

- local GDP;
- internet users;
- R & D & I;
- IoT;
- internet banking;
- the general motorization rate;
- motor vehicle rate of green vehicles;
- motorization rate of polluting vehicles

**WORKING HYPOTHESES**

**H1:** The rate of urban economic development is significantly and directly proportionally influenced by the efforts to implement the R & D & I results and by the openness of the inhabitants in the use of the IT infrastructure for the management of financial flows.

**H2:** Urban economic development does not significantly influence the pro-ecological attitude of the inhabitants. In order to activate it, administrative steps are engaged in terms of infrastructure and service networks.

**H3:** The development of IoT is directly related to the openness of the inhabitants in the use of IT infrastructure for the management of financial flows.

**H4:** The smart maximization function is valid and adequate if and only if there is a minimum level of each of the above indicators for an urban population correctly dimensioned according to the urban environments and the minimum level of economic capacity measured by the rate of the urban economic development.
